**WARNING**

Read label before use. Keep out reach of children. This material is quite bland; with vapour, occasional skin contact and even minor ingestion having negligible hazard. Repeated skin contact may, and any eye contact will, cause irritation.

**PRECAUTIONS**

USE WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION. DO NOT EAT, DRINK OR SMOKE WHILE USING.

Store in original or correctly labelled container, tightly closed, in a well ventilated area indoors, away from foodstuffs, either between 15°C-20°C or at a cool, constant temperature. Dispose of empty container safely. Consult Resene checklist on environmentally acceptable methods of cleaning equipment and disposing of unwanted paint. Do not contaminate any water supply. Avoid release to the environment.

**FIRST AID**

IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.

IF ON SKIN (or hair): Remove/take off all contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. Rinse skin with plenty of soap and water/shower. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical attention/advice.

IF INHALED: If breathing is difficult, remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing.

# Interior Paintwork Cleaner

**Resene Interior Paintwork Cleaner is a labour saving non-dulling neutral cleaner designed for use on all interior painted surfaces. Quick and easy to use, it dries film-free eliminating the need for rinsing.**

This pack is supplied in ready to use form. Do not dilute contents.

- Dip a soft lint free cloth, such as a Jif Ballerina, into the diluted detergent solution. Do not saturate the cloth as this could lead to runs and streaking. If using a spray pack, apply the Paintwork Cleaner direct to the surface you wish to clean.
- Using light strokes, thoroughly wipe the area to be cleaned turning the cloth frequently to maintain a clean edge. Wipe away any excess solution. Wring the cleaning cloth out into an empty bucket before reapplying further detergent solution. This will minimise the appearance of streaks. In order to achieve an even finish, finally wipe using a soft dry lint-free cloth in the direction of the paint flow.
- If trying to remove a localised mark, start from a radius wide of the mark and work towards it. This will minimise any 'tide mark' that might develop.
- Always test the cleaning method in an inconspicuous area to ensure the cleaning process you plan to use does not damage the finish of the paint. Wait until the test area has dried before using the same technique on more conspicuous areas. Walls may appear discoloured as they absorb the water, but should dry back to their original colour.
- Do not vigorously scrub the surface nor use an abrasive and strong detergent as you may burnish the paint surface and mar the paint finish. Do not wash walls for a month after painting, as waterborne paints require this period of time to fully develop their properties.
- If you have sensitive skin, gloves are recommended.

In every case it is recommended that the appropriate Safety Data Sheet is consulted prior to application.
